Multiple-Sleeper Motorhome Makeover <u>by</u> Villa International

"The dinette was the logical place to start," said Robert Long, vice president of sales for Villa International. "In addition, by flip-flopping the dinette and J lounge, we could add a second Inflatable sofa bed within the J side of the ensemble. The end result turned out better than expected."



The newest feature is the dinette itself. Twin facing jack-knife dinette benches fold down into a bed without using the table for support. This enables a more elegant, larger table to be used for the dining surface. The table detaches from the wall and stows down between the benches on the floor, between the tapered kick-boards. The benches are made from tubular steel and the seat cushions meet in the middle with the back pillow

folding down flat. Since you sleep perpendicular to the folds, they are not noticeable.



"We really were happy with the comfort and size of the dinette sleeping area," Long said. "The service personnel who installed it were calling sales people over to check it out. The complete floor plan really was impressive when everything was made into beds."



"Who says you need the dinette across from the galley?" says Long. "Motorhomes are evolving every day. With the square footage available in today's quad slide out floor plans and the ease of incorporating flat screen TVs, we really need to step back and literally think outside the box."
